

# Olympion Bible Memory

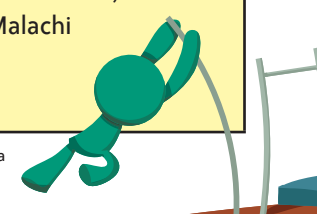
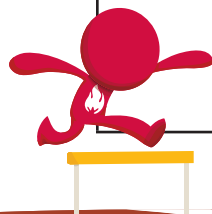
